The Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries, and Parks (MDWFP) invites you to the 64th Annual Southeastern Association of Fish and Wildlife Agencies Conference at the Beau Rivage Resort and Casino, Biloxi, Mississippi, October 17-20, 2010. The fisheries session will include: 1) Oral presentations of peer-reviewed and peer-edited manuscripts to be published in the Southeastern Proceedings; 2) Oral presentations of unpublished studies (limited to space available on the program); and, 3) Posters. Manuscripts on freshwater, marine and estuarine topics, including but not limited to, management, research, and culture are encouraged. Case histories are particularly encouraged.

The deadline for submitting manuscripts, poster, and non-manuscript oral presentation abstracts has been extended to May 14, 2010.

Poster size cannot exceed 4' x 8'. Students: Indicate if you wish to be considered for best student poster award.
